



### Youth4U- Young Inspectors: What is the Offer to each local area?

The Youth4U – Young Inspectors money will not cover all of the costs but we expect this work to match well with existing plans and expectations of giving young people a voice in the design, review and delivery of services locally hence local money will also be in the system

Please note that there are a number of variables eg. speed of start, level of activity which may vary what is outlined below. What we describe is indicative of what may be available to an area that becomes a provider of the Youth4U-Young Inspectors programme.

<p>An apprentice to work with the Local Support Worker</p>	<p>£5-10500 per 12 month period or pro rata if less, to co-fund establishing an apprenticeship</p>	<p>This will be available to up to 20 of the 36 areas. We are particularly keen for apprenticeships to be offered to marginalised young people</p>
<p>Payment to the young inspectors</p>	<p>£75 per completed inspection per young person, payable on receipt of the report</p>	<p>This is based on teams of 4-6 per inspection</p>
<p>Free on-line toolkit guidance is available now on involving disabled young people</p>	<p>Normally priced at £500</p>	
<p>Training including Continual Professional Development Days for</p>	<p>Free of charge- normal cost £3-500pd</p>
